सं. ए-12(11)/1/2013-स्था.-I-कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा अधिनियम, 1948 (1948 का 34) की धारा 97 की उप धारा (2) के खंड (xxi) तथा उप धारा (2क) के साथ पठित उक्त धारा की उप धारा (1) और धारा 17 की उप धारा (2) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए तथा कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा निगम प्रधान निजी सचिव भर्ती विनियम, 2001 के अधिक्रमण में, ऐसे अधिक्रमण से पहले की गई अथवा किए जाने से छूट गई बातों के अलावा, कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा निगम एतद्व्वारा कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा निगम में प्रधान निजी सचिव के पद की भर्ती की पद्वति को विनियमित करने हेतु निम्नलिखित विनियम बनाता है, अर्थात् :--

- संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारम्भ : (1) ये विनियम कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा निगम प्रधान निजी सचिव भर्ती विनियम, 2014 कहे जायेंगे।
   (2) ये शासकीय राजपत्र में इनके प्रकाशन की तिथि से लागू होंगे।
- पदों की संख्या, वर्गीकरण, वेतन बैंड तथा ग्रेड वेतन / वेतनमान : पदों की संख्या, उनका वर्गीकरण और उनसे सम्बद्ध वेतन बैंड तथा ग्रेड वेतन या वेतनमान इन विनियमों के साथ संलग्न अनुसूची के स्तंभ (2) से (4) में यथा विनिर्दिष्ट होंगे।
- भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं आदि : उक्त पदों से संबंधित भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं और अन्य मामले उक्त अनुसूची के स्तंभ (5) से (13) में यथा विनिर्दिष्ट होंगे।

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# EMPLOYEES' STATE INSURANCE CORPORATION

## New Delhi, the 22nd July 2014

No. A-12(11)/1/2013-Estt. I— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 97 read with clause (xxi) of sub-section (2) and sub-section (2A) of that section and sub-section (2) of section 17 of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (34 of 1948), and in supersession of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation Principal Private Secretary Recruitment Regulations, 2001 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Employees' State Insurance Corporation hereby makes the following regulations regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Principal Private Secretary in the Employees' State Insurance Corporation, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These regulations may be called the Employees' State Insurance Corporation, Principal Private Secretary Recruitment Regulations, 2014.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Number of posts, classification, Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay scale.— The number of posts, their classification, Pay Band and Grade Pay or Pay scale attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these regulations.
- 3. The Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc. The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disgualification. No person, -
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living; or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Director General of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these regulations.

5. Power to relax. — Where the Director General of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, after taking the prior approval of the Central Government and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these regulations, with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Residuary matters.— Subject to the provisions of these regulations, all other regulations and instructions, laid down in the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (Recruitment) Regulations, 1965 as amended from time to time, applicable to the corresponding category of posts in the Employees' State Insurance Corporation, shall apply to the post specified in the Schedule annexed to these regulations.

7. Savings.— Nothing in these regulations shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time, in this regard.

Promotion :

Private Secretary with six years' regular service in Pay Band -2 in the pay scale of Rs. 9300-34800 with grade pay of Rs. 4800 (including the service rendered as Private Secretary in Non-functional pay scale in Pay Band-3 in the scale of pay of Rs. 15,600-39,100 with grade pay of Rs. 5,400/-).

Promotion shall be subject to completion of training for promotion to the post of Principal Private Secretary devised by the Employees' State Insurance Corporation.

Those persons who are due to retire within two years shall be exempted from completion of such training :

Provided that those persons who have not completed training for promotion before the date of meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee will also be considered subject to condition that the required training will be completed within one year of the date of meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee.

Note1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/ eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.

Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the  $I^{st}$  day of January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the  $6^{th}$  Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended, based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.

Deputation (including short-term contract):

Officers under the Central or State Governments or Union Territories or Autonomous Bodies:

(A) (I) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department, or

(II) with 6 years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 9300-34800/- with grade pay of Rs. 4800 in Pay Band-2 (including the service rendered as Private Secretary in Non-functional pay scale in Pay Band-3 in the scale of pay of Rs. 15600-39100 with grade pay of Rs. 5400/, if any), or equivalent in the parent cadre/department and

(b) possessing 5 years experience in Stenography work (English/Hindi).

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(The Period of deputation(including short-term contract) including period of deputation(including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or

department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short term contract) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 2: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the  $1^{st}$  January, 2006 i.e. the date from which the revised pay structure based on the  $6^{th}$  CPC recommendation has been extended shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up gradation.
