

189th Meeting of Employees' Sta

The Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) held its 189th Meeting on 4th December 2022, chaired by Shri Bhupender Yadav, Union Minister for Labour and Employment, and Environment, Forest and Climate Change at the ESIC Headquarters. Several important initiatives were announced during the meeting to improve the services offered to insured workers and their dependents.

Given the significant increase in the number of insured workers and their dependents, Shri Bhupender Yadav directed ESIC to focus on strengthening the infrastructure. The Union Labour Minister also informed the attendees about the 'Nirman Se Shakti' initiative that has been launched to modernize and strengthen the infrastructure of ESI hospitals and dispensaries in phases. The initiative is expected to improve access to healthcare services and enhance the quality of care provided to beneficiaries.

The meeting was an opportunity for ESIC and its stakeholders to discuss and review the progress of ongoing initiatives and outline future plans to meet the evolving needs of insured workers and their dependents. The ESIC leadership is committed to delivering on its mandate of providing comprehensive social protection to formal sector workers and will continue to explore innovative ways to improve its services and leverage technology to make access to its services more convenient for beneficiaries.

During the meeting, Shri Rameswar Teli, Minister of State for Labour and Employment, and Petroleum and Natural Gas, Government of India, said that ESIC plans to leverage cutting-edge technologies for construction and monitoring of projects. The use of drones and online real-time dashboards are among the latest advancements to be incorporated.





Key decisions made during the Meeting:

- ESIC approved proposals to establish two new hospitals with 100 beds each in Shyamlibazar, Agartala, Tripura, and Idukki, Kerala, to improve healthcare services and infrastructure for the growing number of insured workers under the ESI Scheme. These hospitals will serve approximately 60,000 beneficiaries each.
- The corporation has approved an increase in the number of seats for admissions under Wards of Insured Persons Quota in ESIC Nursing Colleges in Gulbarga and Bengaluru and the introduction of Ph.D., MDS, nursing, and paramedical courses in its medical institutions nationwide.
- To diversify its investments and address low returns on debt instruments, the ESI Corporation also approved the investment of surplus funds in equity, specifically Exchange Traded Funds such as Nifty50 and Sensex, starting at 5% and gradually increasing up to 15% after two quarterly reviews. The equity investment will be managed by Fund Managers of AMC's and monitored by existing Custodian, External Concurrent Auditor and Consultant responsible for debt investments in addition to ETF management.
- The ESI Corporation has given in-principle approval for the Engineering Wing under the Project Management Division to carry out Annual Repair Maintenance & Operational work and Special Repair works, as well as executing Capital works in ESIC

The Union Labour Minister recognized two winners of the Architectural Design Competition for the upcoming 500-bedded ESIC Hospital in Manesar, awarding them cash prizes of Rs. 2 Lakh and Rs. 1.5 Lakh, respectively. The competition was announced during the hospital's foundation-laying ceremony to encourage young architecture students to develop their skills and create outstanding designs for the hospital. Similar competitions will also be held for the ESIC Hospitals in Sanand and Kalol, Gujarat, to inspire innovative architectural designs.

At the meeting, Shri Bhupender Yadav unveiled the inaugural edition of 'ESI Samachar,' ESIC's monthly digital journal. The Corporation also approved and adopted the Annual Accounts, CAG report, and Annual Report of ESI Corporation for the year 2021-22, along with its analysis.

The meeting was attended by Ms. Dola Sen, MP, Shri Ram Kripal Yadav, MP, Shri Khagen Murmu, MP, Ms. Arti Ahuja, Secretary (L&E), Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Director General, ESIC and Dr. M. Srinivas, Director, AIIMS, New Delhi and Principal Secretaries/Secretaries of the State Governments,

Standing Committee Meeting of ESIC

The 227th Meeting of the Standing Committee of ESIC, chaired by Ms. Arti Ahuja, Secretary of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, was held on January 24th, 2023, at ESIC Hqrs. in New Delhi. The primary agenda of the meeting was to discuss and approve the Revised Estimates for the Year 2022-2023, as well as the Budget Estimates and Performance Budget for the year 2023-2024. After deliberations, the committee approved both the agendas.

Additionally, the Standing Committee also discussed various measures to enhance the service delivery mechanism of ESI Scheme.

Furthermore, during the meeting, the Secretary of Labour & Employment urged States to adopt the Dhanwantri Module of the 'www.esic.gov.in' website promptly. The module is designed to provide hassle-free health services to IPs and their beneficiaries under ESI Scheme. The adoption of this module is expected to bring about a significant improvement in the healthcare services offered under the ESI Scheme.

ESIC Dental College & Hospital Rohini Celebrates Graduation Ceremony for 2015-16 Batch

The Graduation Ceremony of the 2015 and 2016 Batch of ESIC Dental College & Hospital, Rohini was held at the Siri Fort Auditorium in New Delhi on December 14, 2022. The occasion was graced by several eminent personalities including Shri Bhupender Yadav, Union Minister for Labour & Employment and Environment, Forest & Climate Change, who attended as the Chief Guest. ESIC Dental College in Rohini, Delhi, was established in 2010 and is the corporation's first foray into dental and medical education. The college is affiliated to the Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University and recognized by the DCI. The college has an annual intake of up to 62 students for the Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) course and is associated with a 300-bedded hospital located within the premises, along with modern operating rooms

and a 10-bedded ICU in addition to outpatient facilities in various medical departments. The ceremony saw the graduation of 68 students of the 2015-16 Batch, and was attended by Dr. Nagaraj. M, Dean, ESIC Dental College & Hospital, Rohini, faculty members of the dental college, students and their parents, along with officers of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India and ESIC.

Review Meeting

The Review Meeting chaired by Shri Bhupender Yadav, Minister of Labour & Employment, Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India was held on 30th December, 2022 at ESIC Medical College & ESIC Hospital, Joka, Kolkata

A meeting was held at the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Medical College and ESIC Hospital in Joka, Kolkata to review the potential expansion of the ESI health scheme in non implemented districts of the country. The meeting was chaired by Union Minister for Labour & Employment and Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Shri Bhupender Yadav, and focused on improving healthcare services and upgrading infrastructure to better serve Insured Persons and beneficiaries.

During the meeting, Minister reaffirmed the Government's commitment to implementing the ESI health scheme in non-

implemented districts of the country. Shri Rameswar Teli, Minister of State for Labour & Employment and Petroleum & Natural Gas, during meeting, stated that the government's priority is to establish medical infrastructure to ensure that the workers in the country have access to healthcare benefits.

Ms. Arti Ahuja, Secretary, Labour and Employment, Dr. Rajendra Kumar, DG, ESIC and Dr. M Srinivas, Director of AIIMS were also present at the meeting. They offered various suggestions on expansion of the coverage of ESI Scheme, enhancing healthcare services and on prevention of occupational diseases in industrial clusters. They also recommended the use of modern approaches and technology models to provide efficient healthcare services, including the implementation of E-Sanjeevani and the online Dhanwantari application of ESIC.



Review Meeting

ESIC review meeting held in Mumbai to focus on healthcare development for Beneficiaries in Maharashtra

On January 20, 2023, a review meeting of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) was held in Mumbai under the chairmanship of Ms. Arti Ahuja, Secretary, Ministry Labour and Employment, Government of India. The meeting focused on the development of ESIC projects and medical services being provided to insured persons (IPs) and their beneficiaries in Maharashtra. Improving and developing ESIC projects across the state to provide quality health services was deliberated on, with an emphasis on starting the facility of OPD services within three months, followed by IPD services in another six months at the ESIC Model Hospital in Andheri, Mumbai.

The state government officials were asked to provide necessary clearances for the acquisition of lands and other statutory approvals quickly to fast track the provision of medical infrastructure. Additionally, the state government was requested

to allocate land for seven projects in Maharashtra. Dr. Rajendra Kumar, DG, ESIC, Shri Nawin Sona, Principal Secretary, Department of Public Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of Maharashtra, members of ESI Corporation from Maharashtra and other senior officers of ESIC and the Government of Maharashtra were also present during the event.

The ESI Scheme in Maharashtra is supervised through its Regional Office in Mumbai and six Sub-Regional Offices spread throughout the state. The scheme is implemented in 31 districts of Maharashtra, catering to 40 lakh insured persons working at 2.35 lakh units and their 1.50 crore beneficiaries. ESIC services are delivered through 82 branch offices in the state, which includes 14 DCBOs (Dispensary cum Branch Offices), with more 09 DCBOs coming. Medical services are being provided through 15 hospitals (03 ESIC Hospitals and 12 ESIS Hospitals).

कार्यक्रम में कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा योजना के झारखंड क्षेत्र के सभी जिलों में कार्यान्वयन और विकास हेतु सदस्यों द्वारा चर्चा की गई और सचिव ने सुझाव दिया कि इस योजना के प्रचार प्रसार के लिये व्यापक रूप से प्रचार प्रसार करते हुए लाभार्थियों को जागरूक किया जाए। अपर आयुक्त सह क्षेत्रीय निदेशक श्री रामजी लाल मीना द्वारा सूचित किया गया कि नये जिलों में औषधालय सह शाखा कार्यालय की शुरुआत कर दी गई है और अन्य शेष 06 जिलों में भी औषधालय सह शाखा कार्यालय / शाखा कार्यालय की शुरुआत यथाशीघ्र की जाएगी। ताकि झारखंड के सभी जिलों में कर्मचारी राज्य बीमा योजना का लाभ मिल सके।
